CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET

BY-LAW NUMBER 2013-02

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOSITION OF LATE PAYMENT CHARGES FOR NON-PAYMENT OF TAXES.

WHEREAS under the provisions of the *Municipal Act, 2001* as amended, a municipality may impose late payment charges for the non-payment of taxes;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

1. THAT a penalty charge of 1.25 percent be charged on the instalment of taxes due and unpaid on the first day of default, being the first calendar day of each month;
2. AND THAT an interest charge of 1.25% percentage be calculated on the total amount of taxes due and unpaid on the first day of each calendar month that the taxes remain unpaid;
3. AND THAT this by-law shall come into effect January 1, 2013.

CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NEWMARKET

BY-LAW NUMBER 2013-03

A BY-LAW TO CONFIRM THE PROCEEDINGS OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL – JANUARY 21, 2013.

WHEREAS s. 5(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the powers of a municipal corporation shall be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS s. 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Newmarket deems it advisable to pass such a by-law;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

1. THAT subject to Section 3 of this by-law, every decision of Council, as evidenced by resolution or motion, taken at the meeting at which this by-law is passed, shall have the same force and effect as if each and every one of them had been the subject matter of a separate by-law duly enacted;
2. AND THAT the execution and delivery of all such documents as are required to give effect to the decisions taken at the meeting at which this by-law is passed and the resolutions passed at that meeting are hereby authorized;
3. AND THAT nothing in this by-law has the effect of giving to any decision or resolution the status of a by-law where any legal prerequisite to the enactment of a specific by-law has not been satisfied;
4. AND THAT any member of Council who disclosed a pecuniary interest at the meeting at which this by-law is passed shall be deemed to have disclosed that interest in this confirmatory by-law as it relates to the item in which the pecuniary interest was disclosed.
