

COMMENTS

Licensing fees fall into either the Community Supported Good or Consumer Good category in the Service Pricing Policy, placing them at a 60 -100% cost recovery.

Legislative Services has increased the majority of the 2014 licensing fees by 3% and over the last year or two have been increasing fees to bring them closer to the 60 - 90% target range. Dog and cat licensing fees have not been recommended to be increased for 2014.

All recreation and culture fees and charges are categorized by user and type of service. Target cost recovery levels are established and reviewed against targeted cost recovery target ranges. The attached Schedules represent Recreation & Culture Services fees and charges levied by the municipality that are not linked to specific legislation. Approval of the Recreation and Culture rates and fees at this time enables the fees to take effect as of January 1, 2014, and be included in the Winter/Spring Guide that is in development.

The 2014 budget process identified an overall 3.0% targeted rates and fees related revenue increase. **The total projected revenue increase in a 2013 to 2014 budget comparison is 3.1%.**

This does not translate into every program and service increasing by this rate. The proposed fee change varies from program to program. While some services/programs do not propose increases due to any number of considerations, others are subject to a higher than 3.0% targeted increase. The 3.1% represents a budget to budget increase in overall projected rates and fees related revenues (the 2013 budget against the current 2014 draft budget).

NOTE:

For ease of review, any individual rate that increases more than 4% has been highlighted on the attached schedules.

In order to better reflect the financial impact of the proposed fees and charges, they were reviewed against the budgeted volumes (projected participation) and revenues associated with the draft 2014 operating budget. In addition, in the establishment of any and all fees, Recreation and Culture review includes:

- Registration history of a program/service and potential impact, if any, of a fee increase on future participation numbers;
- Program life cycle (ie: new program vs well established program);
- Marketplace considerations (including target market for any given program);
- Price sensitivity points for any program; potential for participation to drop based on price (points of diminishing return);
- Specific demographic considerations and trends;
- Special considerations (ie: inclusion program opportunity, etc);
- Linkage with the Service Pricing Policy.

One highlight within the proposed 2014 rates and fees is a reduction in the drop in rates for swim, track, gym, and public skating. This also has a corresponding impact on multi use passes. This move builds on the lessons learned from the pilot project conducted at the Sk8park in 2012 when drop in rates were reduced and resulted in a dramatic increase in utilization. Staff anticipates a similar trend to occur across these other drop in activities and have forecasted volume (participation) accordingly in the 2014 budget. It will be monitored closely throughout the year.

On the heels of the Service Price Policy Review, Recreation and Culture will factor in cost recovery and pricing reviews directly or indirectly during the development of the Recreation Master Plan.


Recreation and Culture proposes a 3.1% increase in revenue across rates and fees related revenue lines in the 2014 operating budget compared to the 2013 budget.



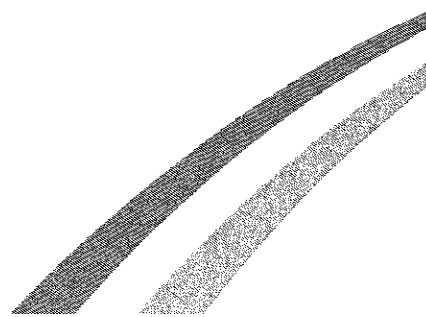
Council has the authority to exempt portions of registered plans from the part lot control provisions of the *Planning Act*, granted by Section 50(5) of the *Act*, to permit, among other reasons, the sale of townhouse and semi-detached residential units provided that the land use to be accommodated by the exemption, the parcel to be created, and any remaining parcel, are in conformity with the governing Official Plan and are permitted by the Zoning Bylaw in effect in the area in question.

The passage of a bylaw to exempt the residential lots from part lot control will permit the conveyance of each half of the semi-detached units to separate owners.

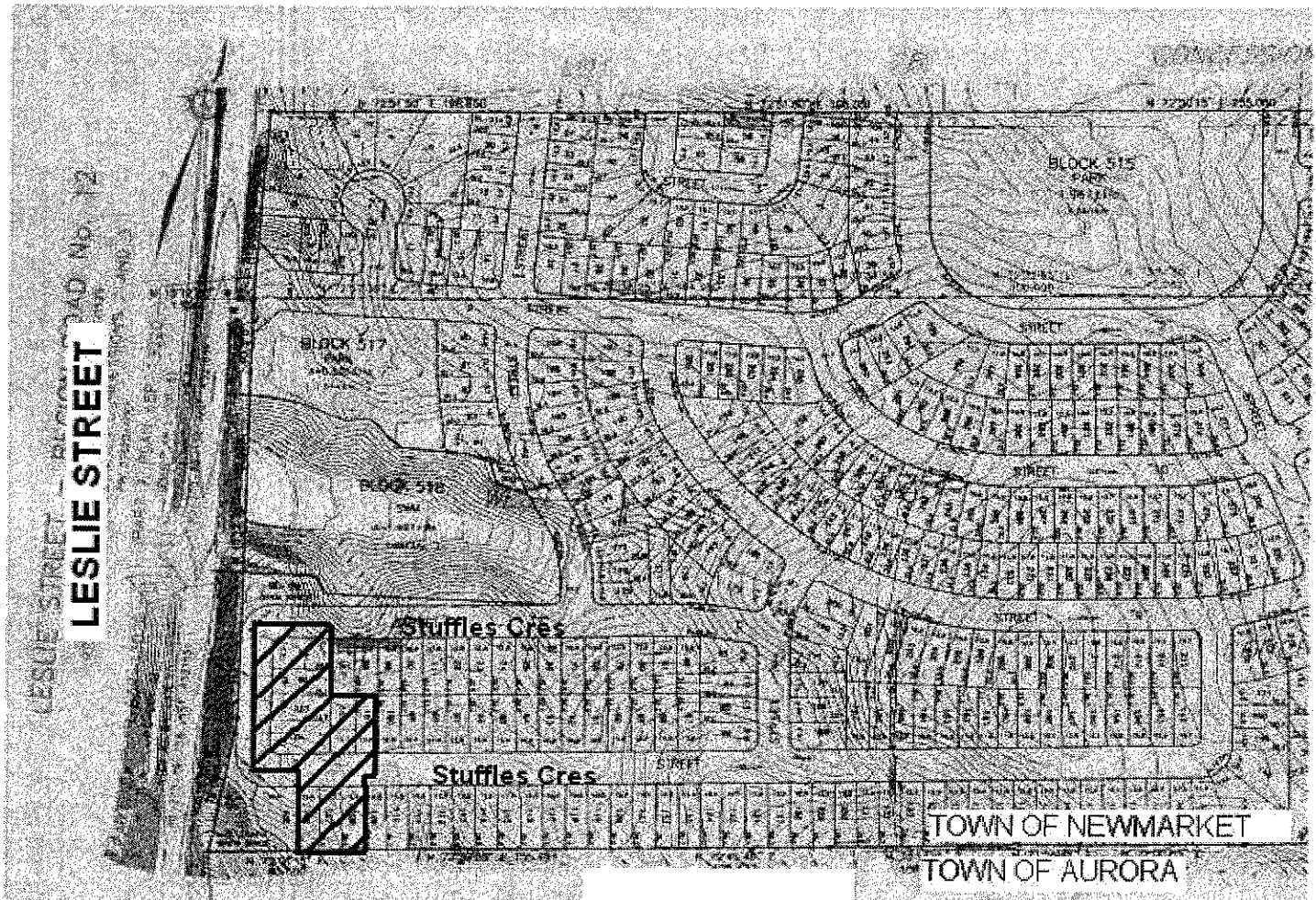

A BY-LAW TO CONFIRM THE PROCEEDINGS OF A MEETING OF COUNCIL – SEPTEMBER 9, 2013.

WHEREAS s. 5(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the powers of a municipal corporation shall be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS s. 5(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges, shall be exercised by by-law unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Newmarket deems it advisable to pass such a by-law;

THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

1. THAT subject to Section 3 of this by-law, every decision of Council, as evidenced by resolution or motion, taken at the meeting at which this by-law is passed, shall have the same force and effect as if each and every one of them had been the subject matter of a separate by-law duly enacted;
2. AND THAT the execution and delivery of all such documents as are required to give effect to the decisions taken at the meeting at which this by-law is passed and the resolutions passed at that meeting are hereby authorized;
3. AND THAT nothing in this by-law has the effect of giving to any decision or resolution the status of a by-law where any legal prerequisite to the enactment of a specific by-law has not been satisfied;
4. AND THAT any member of Council who disclosed a pecuniary interest at the meeting at which this by-law is passed shall be deemed to have disclosed that interest in this confirmatory by-law as it relates to the item in which the pecuniary interest was disclosed.
