2. Ms. Nicole Wellsbury, Director of Legislative and Information Services, Town Clerk addressed the Committee with a PowerPoint Presentation highlighting the "Town of Ajax online voting experience." Topics included main motivators for adopting online voting such as accessibility, environmental sustainability and the integrity of the voting process. Ms. Wellsbury also addressed the impact on voter turnout, gave an overview of the Town of Ajax's demographics, the voting location models, authentication process, challenges with the Voter List, the communication plan and approach, recommendations for the 2018 election and an overview of feedback the Town received from their post-election survey (was conducted in conjunction with Dr. Nicole Goodman, Centre for E-Democracy). Members of Council queried Ms. Wellsbury with questions relating to the Ajax model, costs, staffing and the accuracy of the voters list.
