## What is the Ian Gray Environment award?

The Ian Gray Environment Award is given out by the Newmarket Environmental Advisory Committee (NEAC), to provide schools with financial support for environmental goals and to recognize outstanding projects and achievements.

The Ian Gray Environment Award consists of **three \$500 start-up grants** and **one annual prize** for a completed school project with an environmental focus.

The award and grants are available to support school projects that target current environmental issues in Newmarket, enhance environmental awareness and lead to a more sustainable community.

## Who can apply?

NEAC invites all schools in Newmarket (public, Catholic, private, K-12) to submit an application for the Ian Gray Environment Award.

## Ian Gary Environment Award grant criteria

**Grants** and the **annual prize** will be awarded for projects that address a minimum of one of the following criteria.

Projects that:

- Improve air quality
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions
- Conserve water
- Manage waste by reducing composting, or recycling
- Use energy wisely
- Improve biodiversity of wetlands, rivers or school grounds

Projects will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Clear benefit to the community
- Contains a long term and sustainable vision
- Unique and innovative ideas

The Newmarket Environmental Advisory Committee (NEAC) acts as an advisory body and resource group to the Town of Newmarket Council and staff in planning and operational matters pertaining to ways to inventory, protect, maintain, restore and enhance the environment.
