

## **Corporation of the Town of Newmarket**

## By-law 2019-XX

A By-law to amend By-Law 2014-27, being a By-Law to define the Procurement Policies for the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket.

Whereas Section 270 of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended provides that a municipality shall adopt and maintain policies with respect to its procurement of goods and services;

And whereas Council enacted By-Law 2014-27 to define the Procurement policies and procedures for the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket, hereinafter, called "the Owner", and it is now deemed necessary to amend By-Law 2014-27;

Therefore be it enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Newmarket as follows:

- 1. THAT Schedule "A" Exceptions to Procurement By-Law 2014-27 (the "By-law") be amended to include acquisitions from government bodies, non-governmental bodies that exercise governmental authority delegated to them, and non-profit organizations as set out in the Canadian Free Trade Agreement ("CFTA") and other applicable trade treaties; and
- 2. THAT that provision "x" of Section 13.6, Single Source, that states the following, "Notwithstanding anything in this by-law, where a purchase is determined by Council to be fair and reasonable and is made from a non-profit corporation supported by the Owner, the Owner may make such a purchase as a single source purchase", be deleted; and
- 3. THAT Schedule "D" of the Procurement By-Law include a new Table 9- exceptions for acquisitions with governmental bodies, non-governmental bodies that exercise governmental authority delegated to them and non-profit organizations;
- 4. THAT the new Table 9 to Schedule "D" delegate authority to staff as follows:
