I oppose the rollback of environmental protections for the Moraine lands in the southwest corner of Newmarket. The Mayor and Council should not be required to spend time and money to revisited council's past decisions every few years.

Presumably the developer was aware of the designation of the lands when he acquired them. The land hasn't changed except to become more precious as green declines.

The fact that Aurora and York are treating the Moraine differently doesn't mean Newmarket should follow suit. Each region must do what is right for them, other wise why not just have the same rules for all Ontario.

I'm against any change of status.
