More highways is not the answer. There are other alternatives.

We must stop paving over our farmland, wetlands, watersheds and forests!

If we don't stop this at once, the added pollution (just from road salt alone) will kill Lake Simcoe within 38 years.

If you build more highway lanes, more drivers will fill them up. ... But it still hasn't stemmed the tide of big, expensive highway infrastructure projects as a Band-Aid to congestion.

We must stop this now.
