4.2 2021 Audit Service Plan

Pina Colavecchia of Deloitte Canada provided an overview of the 2021 Audit service plan to the Committee, including the audit scope and materiality thresholds. She provided key highlights of what had changed in the service plan since the previous year. She asked the members for comments regarding any fraud risks. The Chair advised that since the Committee is independent of the Town, they would not be able to answer this question.

It was noted that while the audit included the Newmarket Public Library, the Audit Committee does not have a role regarding the Newmarket Public Library. Members of the Audit Committee discussed the relationship between the internal auditors and independent auditors, new accounting standards, asset retirement, and the role of the auditor in the case of staff complaints.

Members of the Audit Committee discussed the role of the internal auditor and the relation between the Audit Committee and the internal auditor, as well as the need for a connection between the internal auditor and independent auditor. Staff advised that work was needed to improve the connections between the three groups.
