Purpose

The purpose of this report is to seek Council endorsement of the Mulock Park Public Art Plan that has been developed by consultants ART+ PUBLIC UnLtd, in consultation with lead architects, PLANT Architects.

Background

Public Art will play an integral role in the creation of iconic spaces within Mulock Park.

To develop a fully comprehensive plan for the site, ART + PUBLIC UnLtd was engaged through our architects, PLANT Architects. The process of plan development began in August 2021 with information gathering and research. Extensive stakeholder engagement followed.

In November 2021, a public art high level strategy was presented to Council. This was followed by an update on the strategy and progress to the general public through a PIC in December 2021.

ART + PUBLIC UnLtd, took the feedback from Council and public on the strategy to develop the comprehensive plan attached.

Discussion

The public art program vision states: Public Art at Mulock Park celebrates the landscape through a lens of innovation to highlight stories across past, present and future that expand our understanding of nature and our relationship to the land.

This vision will be realized through 4 key program components: embedded permanent art, art opportunities across the site, the artist studio and temporary programming. These program components are fully explained within the attached plan.

Conclusion

The Mulock Park Public Art Plan sets forth a roadmap that will maximize the benefits of public art in creating an iconic space and a memorable experience within Mulock Park.
