5.1 MV-2022-023

The applicant is proposing the construction of rear deck. The following relief is requested from Zoning By-law 2010-40, as amended:

1. Relief from Section 8 Exemption 83. Development Standards, to permit a deck with a rear yard setback measured to the stairs of 10.21m whereas the By-law requires a minimum rear yard setback measured to the stairs of 13.00m.

Annette Martinez, appeared before the Committee and identified themselves as the authorized agent representing the Minor Variance Application MV-2022-023, on behalf of the owner.

Ms. Martinez, stated the proposed design consists of a new elevated deck. Due to conditions on the property they are unable to meet the Zoning requirements for rear yard setback. Ms. Martinez spoke to the easement on the subject property.
