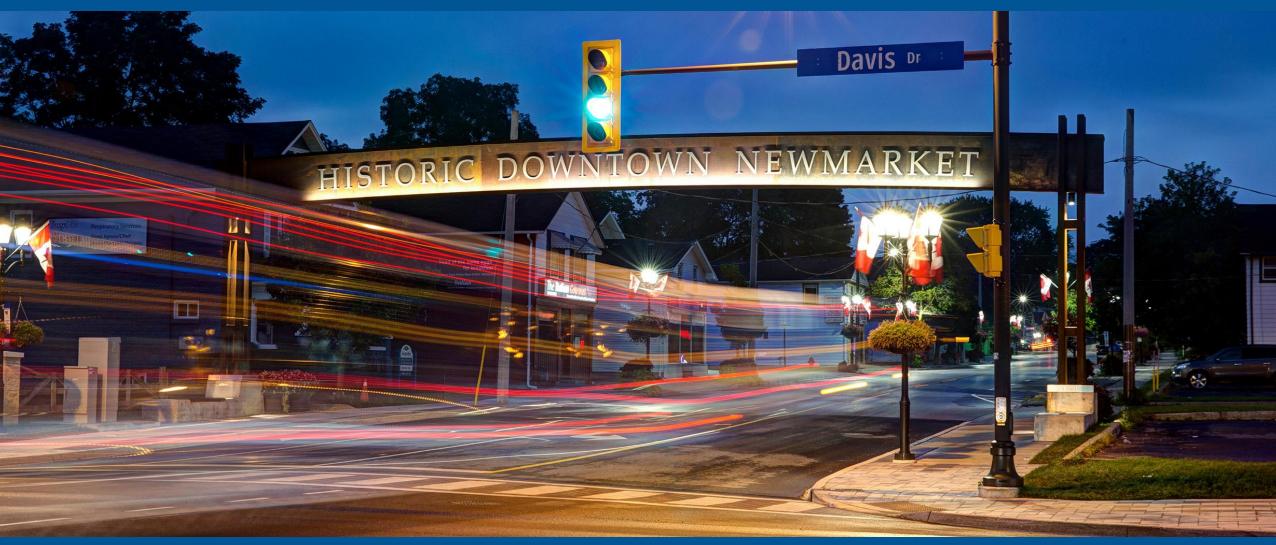

1. Capital Budget Definitions

- Capital Budget approved funding for annual capital expenditures
- Two tests:
 - Capacity projects can be delivered in the fiscal year
 - Financial funding is limited to availability of each individual source
- Capital program projects within the capital budget
- Capital Spending Authority (CSA) total of all approved capital expenditures for current and future years
 - oFor projects that will take more than a year to complete





1. Capital Budget Components

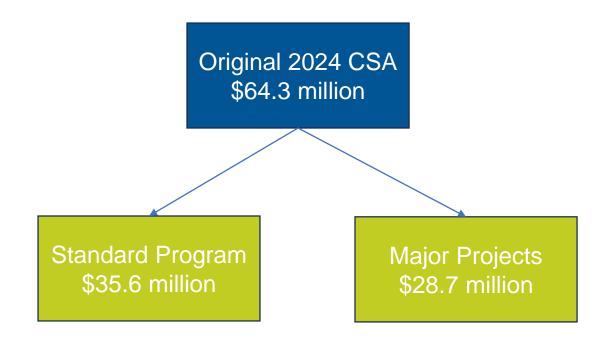
Component	Criteria
Standard	 Restricted to resource capacity
Major projects	 Not restricted to resource capacity due to dedicated capital project staff Project value > \$1 million





1. Capital Budget 2024 Capital Spending Authority

 2024 Capital Spending Authority (CSA) - 2023 Projects that will continue in future years and identify required future funding to ensure continuity and funding stability







1. Capital Budget Changes to 2024 Capital Spending Authority

Original 2024 CSA \$64.3 million

Acceleration to 2023 \$7.0 million

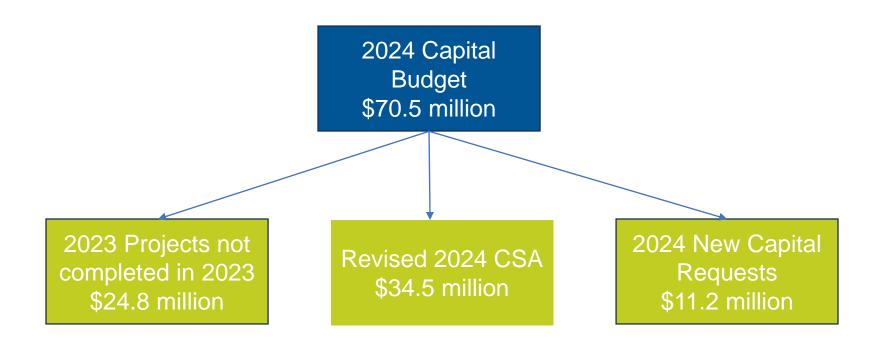
Deferral to 2025 \$22.6 million Cancelled Program \$0.2 million

Remain in 2024 \$34.5 million

3. Rate-Supported Operating Budget Water & Wastewater

- Increase by 3.5%
- Accounts for:
 - Region's increase of 3.3%
 - Day-to-day operations
 - Contribution to ARF totaling \$8.9 million

• Based on annual consumption of 200m³, the 2024 annual increase is \$48



3. Rate-Supported Operating Budget Stormwater

- Increase based on the hybrid approach to phase-in the onetime increase over three years
- Accounts for:
 - Day-to-day operations
 - Contribution to ARF totaling \$6.9 million
