Mandate

- The Heritage Newmarket Advisory Committee was established to assist the Town of Newmarket in achieving its goals for the documentation and preservation of historical structures, buildings, properties and artifacts by advising and assisting Council on matters related to designation under Parts IV and V of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, the conservation of historic structures and the architectural and natural heritage of the community.

Accomplishments

- Advised on Heritage Permits and applications for various properties: 16874 Bayview, Bogart House (16860 Leslie Street), 93 Main Street South, and a plaque request at 389 Simcoe St
- Advised on removing 127 Joseph Street from the non-designated list of heritage properties, supported as per an Unsafe Order issued by Building Services
- Successful application for the Postmark Hotel to receive the Lieutenant Governor's Ontario Heritage Award (2024)
